# What is EHCH?

#### **EHCH Aims:**

- Proactive care that is centred on the needs of individual residents, their families and care home staff.
- Maintain their independence as far as possible
- Staff working in care homes feel at the heart of an integrated team
- Budgets and incentives are aligned so that all parts of the system work together to improve people's health and wellbeing
- Health and social care services are commissioned in a coordinated manner, and the role of the social care provider market is properly understood by commissioners and providers across health and social care.

### **Data**

- Gathering, plotting, using in MDT. 'no lift policy' meeting with regional managers, identifying individual cases of falls.
- Linking in with Council for quality monitoring re. care in homes.
- Feb July falls data from care homes, looking at demographics, finding info why falling, mechanism of falls, risk factors associated with falls. Time of day, GCS scores, bone protective medication.
- ACB scores.
- Asking for certain info from EMAS and ECP notes. Have falls assessment after fall.

#### **Risk Factors for Falls**

#### Total of 114 patients:

**Age:** 110 of the total cohort are 65 years old or older

**History of falls:** 76 people have a history of falls.

#### Polypharmacy: 71

Medical problems affecting mobility, muscle weakness, vision, cognition, and alcohol misuse

# Health and Wellbeing Coach DCCT

- Keith HWBC mobility, strength and stretching work with chairbased exercises and games. Goal to signposting towards sessions in the trust.
- Taking transport into consideration. Sessions such as coffee mornings, Stadium Tours and sporting memories, older people and dementia.
- No plan to withdraw. Aiming for 10 care homes to be involved.



# Falls Prevention

- Addressing modifiable falls risk factors using React To Falls
- Aiming for Care Home staff to feel empowered and competent to be at the centre of Falls Prevention
- Promoting everyone working in care homes to assess a resident's fear of falling









# Pharmacy

- Team consisting of one pharmacist and one pharmacy technician
- Supporting Heatherton House: Medicines reconciliation following hospital discharge and for new residents; structured medication reviews
- Anticholinergic burden (ACB): audit and reviewing potential impact of high ACB scores to prevent falls, cognitive decline and improve cardiovascular outcomes
- Supporting care homes with medication queries, urgent script not being issued, supporting organisation of medicines in care homes, reducing missed medication by residents
- Bone health

# Admiral Nurses

- 2 Admiral Nurses Sophie Dodsworth and Stephanie Clarke.
- Supporting EHCH staff (including ECPs) with input for residents living with dementia for specialist advice and signposting to the most appropriate service.
- See patients if they are not appropriate for CMHT, DRRT, or Dementia Palliative Care Team.
- Can support complex decision making and if family and residents are struggling with dementia diagnosis, maintaining relationships, guilt and anticipatory grief.
- DiADem Diagnosis of advanced dementia.

## Project plans

- Continence: Ontex supplies pads for care homes, device monitoring when a pad is full. Trialled in wards improved weight, skin, behaviour. Keen to trial in a care home supporting with this.
- Esther patient education re. falls, what to do, when they are at risk
- Bone health
- Improving quality of structured medication reviews undertaken in other care homes.
